Each petition must be delivered to the county in which the voter is registered. We have received permission from the state to deliver petitions directly to the Supervisor of Elections in each county without paying a fee. If you have collected petitions in your county, please drop them off at the supervisor of elections rather than mailing them to Orlando. This will save us time, energy, and postage. If you have signed petitions for a county other than where you live, mail them in soon. We need to get these verified to prove we are a viable movement, in turn bringing us national attention and funds.
